

## Victory Family Camp Rules 2023

1. Campers are not permitted to leave the grounds without permission from the Camp director or the board of directors.
2. No campers are allowed inside of or sitting on vehicles.
3. Concerning the conduct of couples of the opposite gender: Public displays of affection such as kissing, hugging, holding hands, or any other action not conducive to good Christian conduct will not be tolerated. Couples are to remain in approved areas of the campus designated by the Steering committee at all times.
4. All campers must attend and be prompt at all meals and meetings unless excused by the camp directors or the Steering Committee.
5. All registered campers are required to wear their name badges at all times excluding Swim times.
6. Campers are not to enter another's dorm except by permission of the steering committee or a worker of that dorm. Boys are not permitted to enter the area of the girl's dorms, and vice-versa.

Being that youth camp is a place where we come to focus on our relationship with God and with other Apostolic young people, no camper or worker shall have in their possession at any time: knives, guns, weapons, fireworks, drugs, tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, televisions, and any electronic games or media, etc. **Phones will be allowed for pictures and calling parents they must not be used for playing Games and internet use at all...** No other electronics, **NO VIDEO OR MOVIES** will be allowed... if camper is caught breaking this rule, item may be taken and given back Friday morning. **(NO EXCEPTIONS)**

7. Vile, rude or profane language is prohibited, and will not be tolerated.
8. All should give respect to the campgrounds, buildings, and facilities. Anyone defacing or destroying property must pay the damage incurred and will be immediately dismissed.
9. Campers are not permitted to use internet in any form while at camp.
10. Every camper, volunteer, and staff member must be responsible for his or her own bedding, towels, clothing, luggage, and personal belongings.
11. Athletic equipment and facilities will be managed by the activity Directors and may be used as specified by them.
12. No Pajama Pants or pants of any kind for Girls sleep wear, Gowns ONLY
13. Campers are required to stay in their living quarters each night, from the time of "lights out" until time to rise, except for emergency.
14. No change or switching of bed assignment, is allowed without previous consent of the Camp Directors or designated authority.
15. It is required that everyone dress modestly and groom themselves neatly at all times, with no makeup or jewelry. No clothing with vulgar distasteful or suggestive logos, pictures, or slogans is permitted. No clothing that is revealing or form-fitting can be worn on the campground at any time.  
**Girls:** Dresses or a skirt and blouse must be worn, with dress or skirt length below the knee at all times (**even while sitting**); sleeves must be below the elbow, no printed or designer hose no dresses or skirts with slits or splits. Shoes must be worn outside of the dormitories at all Times except when swimming.
16. **Swim wear... No swim suits, no bikini, Swim wear must come to the knees, NO EXCEPTION.**

**Boys:**

17. No facial hair: a neat and masculine haircut as follows—no hair covering any parts of the ears, hair not to hang over the top of the collar. No shorts allowed. Regular slacks or jeans must be worn; wind pants and /or sweats will be only permitted during recreation, shirt sleeves below the elbow. Shoes must be worn outside dormitories at all times except when swimming.
18. **Swim wear... No swimming Trunks, Swimwear must come to the knees, NO EXCEPTION**
19. Those who refuse to sign all requested forms will not be accepted.
20. In the event of an unspecified situation not addressed by these rules, it shall be the responsibility of the Camp Steering Committee to make a discreet decision concerning the matter.
21. Any areas of disciplinary action that occurs or deemed necessary will be referred to (Mid-West Youth Camp steering committee) The camp reserves the right to reject or dismiss any applicant [camper or worker] not complying with the camp rules or who is deemed to have questionable character.
22. Only registered campers will be allowed on campus during daytime camp activities, unless prior arrangements are made. Evening services are open to everyone.
23. **NO WRESTLING**

NOTE: campers bear SOLE responsibility for any lost or stolen electronics. For this reason, we ask that you leave them at home. We will not be responsible for them
